The Galleries Gift Shop helps to support and promote artists from North Carolina and surrounding states by offering unique, hand-crafted artwork for sale. Our inventory includes greeting cards, pottery, jewelry, glass, prints, books, wooden goods, original art and much more.

Artists who are interested in selling their work in The Galleries Gift Shop are invited to submit a proposal for review. Artists are selected on an ongoing basis.

### Submission Process:

- Please [email](#) Visual Arts Director, Rebecca Collins with the following information:
  - Name, address, phone number, e-mail address, website and/or social media account(s)
  - Description of work
  - Retail price list
  - A short paragraph about yourself as an artist and why you think your work would be a good fit for The Galleries Gift Shop
  - 5 images representative of your work; digital images should be 300dpi, saved in JPEG format and no larger than 1MB
- All work will be reviewed for consideration. We look for high quality, original items that display creativity, technical skill, consistent quality and salability. Applicants will be notified by e-mail if accepted.
- Accepted artists will be asked to review the terms of the agreement and deliver/ship items for sale.
- Do not bring original work to the gallery unless requested.

### Conditions:

- The Cabarrus Arts Council retains a 40% commission on all items sold in the Gift Shop.
- Artists are paid on their consignment sales each month.
- All mediums are welcome, but space is limited.
- Work will be displayed for a minimum of six months. The display period may be extended at the Cabarrus Arts Council's discretion.
