



ORGANIZATIONAL SUPPORT GUIDELINES

Purpose

Organization Support Grants are available to support local arts organizations in Cabarrus County. The purpose of this grant is to stabilize and strengthen arts organizations that provide high quality arts programming for the citizens of Cabarrus County.

Application deadline: September 13, 2024 at NOON via email to heather@cabarrusartscouncil.org

Eligibility

Organizations that meet the eligibility requirements below may apply for Organization Support Grants, however eligibility shall not guarantee funding.

An eligible organization:

- Is a private, non-profit arts organization classified by the Internal Revenue Service as 501(c)(3)
- Has a mission that focuses solely on the arts
- Is located in Cabarrus County and provides at least 75% of its programs and services in Cabarrus
- Has been in operation for at least one full fiscal year

Funding

- Organization Support Grants support general operating costs.
- Organizations that provide arts programs year-round may apply for up to 25% of their operational budget.
- Organizations may apply for one arts council grant per cycle. Reporting for any prior grant must be completed.

Grant monies may not be used for: Capital expenses; Debt reduction; Food or beverages for hospitality; or Lobbying expenses

Application Procedure

- Final reports are due no later than NOON on June 15, 2025
